



Terms and Conditions

At Nature Beanz Adventures we consider the health, safety and comfort of our participants our number one priority. For this reason, we have set out guidelines to ensure that everyone attending our sessions has a positive experience. We kindly ask that when booking a session, you take a moment to look over our policies, thank you.

Bushcraft & Nature Activities

By signing up to attend our sessions, you agree that you and your child may be involved in activities that involve "risky play". Although we take every step possible to ensure our activities are safe, there is still an unlikely possibility of accidents occurring. In recognising this, we hold full public liability insurance and all of our staff are first aid trained.

Clothing

When attending a session, participants are asked to ensure they are wearing the correct weather appropriate clothing, especially sturdy footwear (no open toes shoes or sandals). We reserve the right to refuse entry to participants who are not appropriately dressed, without a refund.

Weather

Our sessions will go ahead whatever the weather with the exception of high winds or thunderstorms. In the event of high winds of 30mph or above are predicted, sessions will be cancelled. In this instance, you will be informed of this at the earliest opportunity and offered an alternative session. This information will be displayed on our Facebook page and we will contact parents ASAP

Nuts

As our sessions operate outdoors we cannot guarantee that the site will be a 100% nut free environment. There is a possibility of nuts from trees such as hazel or even being left behind by wildlife, we do however ask that parents refrain from bringing nuts to sessions. Please

inform us if you or your child has a nut allergy so we can do our best to accommodate your needs.

Sickness

Please do not attend our sessions if you or your child is suffering from any illness that may be contagious. Please inform us that you will not be attending (children should not attend within 48 hour of vomiting or diarrhoea) If your child becomes unwell during one of our sessions please let us know immediately.

Knives/tools/lighters

Although our activities may include the use of knives, tools and fire steels, we ask that participants refrain from bringing their own personal equipment to sessions. All of our equipment is safety tested to ensure it is fit for use prior to our sessions and will be used under close supervision by trained professionals. If a participant is found with any such items, they will be confiscated until the end of the session to ensure the safety of the whole group.

Cancellations & refunds

In the unlikely event that our sessions are cancelled you will be offered an alternative session. If for any reason you need to cancel a booking you will need to inform us ASAP so your space can be offered to someone else. A refund will only be offered if we are informed with a minimum of 24 hours notice otherwise, we will be unable to offer you a refund.
